

Note booking rules:

- All pages must be numbered in advance all the way to page 140. This will be your first grade.
- Even numbered pages on the left side, odd numbered pages on the right side
- Pen, pencil, colored pencils or crayons may be used
- No highlighters or markers (they soak through).
- No glue, tape only. Please do not put tape on desks or lab counters.
- Everyone needs their own tape, scissors, and writing implements. Borrowing disrupts the classroom, slows others from completing their work, and uses up the supplies of others.
- You should not have to borrow supplies from Ms. Daku. If you have trouble purchasing supplies make Ms. Daku aware, she will help those in need.
- Do not remove pages from your lab notebook, you will need them all.
- If you lose your notebook you will have to recreate it from the last grading period.
- Your assignments and labs must be on the exact page as modeled to you by Ms. Daku on the document camera.
- Your notebook will be due on test days; you will be given a rubric in advance. 50 percent of your grade is earned through your notebook and the other 50% from exams.
- You may check your notebook format against Ms. Daku's. Do not remove the model notebook from the front counter.
- If you have been absent come before or after school to look at Ms. Daku's notebook, or look at a classmate's notebook. Questions about labs should be directed to Ms. Daku after checking out a text from the library, reading the activity missed, and getting data (Ms. Daku will help provide you with data).
- You will not test well if you do not engage in labs, test questions often based on the labs.
- No loose papers, no papers hanging over edges

Lab Rules

- Safety first, follow all directions
- Keep your voices down and your behavior calm
- Do not throw objects
- Do not visit with other groups during labs
- Stay with your assigned group, no trading team members.
- Do not leave your lab group unless you are doing a job for the group
- Everyone participates, everyone's ideas are of value, be kind.
- Help clean up
- No unauthorized experiments
- No abuse of equipment, you will be asked to replace broken lab equipment
- Violations of lab etiquette will result in an e-grade of zero (see syllabus)
